I also spoke to my doctor and other health professionals about things that are important to me at the end of my life.



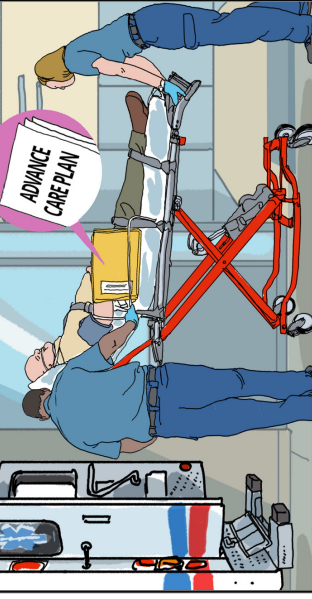
I understand that one day I might not be able to make decisions so I identified who would be my substitute decision maker.
